## HIV &

Prince George's County has reported 7,869 cases of Coronavirus, 263 deaths, and 1,587 hospitalize with COVID-19 in the county. (Updated May 5, 2020)

### HIV and COVID-19

- People living with HIV taking treatment are currently *not* at an increased risk of getting coronavirus.
- People living with HIV **not** on treatment may be at a greater risk. Speak to a healthcare professional about getting treatment.
- People aged 50 and over living with HIV with additional health conditions should be extra careful to prevent the virus and other illness.



## COVID-19



- Keep at least a 30 days' supply of your medicines in your home. If possible, ask for a 3-month supply.
- Remember if you feel sick contact your healthcare provider; and keep in touch if required to self-quarantine.
- Follow the guidelines of your local government; wear a facial mask and gloves.
